Strategic Plan and Vision

Love In the Name of Christ focuses on building relationships with our neighbors and volunteers so that each person seeks Jesus to realize their full potential in life. Our ministries work to understand the root causes of life's struggles so that together we break the cycle of chronic poverty AND chronic giving. Digging deep into the reason why Love INC exists in Sheboygan County, we discovered that hope could change lives.

CONNECTION CENTER:

We saw an increase in the number of requests through our call center, newly named Connection Center, as well as a change in the types of requests.

With a renewed focus on building hope through relationships, we also looked at the types of questions asked and how to provide a more personal touch by reducing the use of voicemail. Moving forward, we plan to expand access to our Connection Center with the addition of a new volunteer role, Connection Center Receptionist.

MENTORING:

While we were considering our call center process, we also investigated the preparedness of our organization to expand services and enter into the realm of mentoring. The flow, from neighbor requests to provision of needs and in-depth relationships with our neighbors, needed to be addressed. We are now identifying key areas for training of staff and volunteers so that we can truly address root causes and provide support structures around individuals who are struggling.

We aim to work together with our neighbors and volunteers to provide access to community resources so that each person lives into their full potential as designed by Christ.

All of these insights into our processes and structure led us to a plan that will allow further development of our foundational ministries as well as growth into more relational ministries that get to the root causes that plague our community.

RESTRUCTURING:

The restructuring of our organization is the culmination of the work done at the task force level and prepares us to **BUILD HOPE** through relationships rooted in Christ together in 2023 and beyond.


New Positions and Roles at Love INC:

Community Impact

Love In the Name of Christ operates within three ministries that rely on the partnerships of local Christian churches:

Love INC Process Flow



- Onnection Center Ministry is our call center where the process and relationship usually begins with a phone call from our neighbors. Volunteers thoughtfully listen to each story; discern with staff to recommend appropriate church & community resources; and assist with class registration and follow up calls. Every phone call is wrapped in prayer and discernment. This ministry is vital to staying connected with our neighbors as we begin to build and strengthen trust.


