SHARING THE ART OF NEIGHBORING

The first ever Love INC (In the Name of Christ) of Sheboygan County "Love Where You Live" — The Art of Neighboring event drew nearly 100 church and community leaders, members and volunteers to City Church in Sheboygan on Monday, October 3rd.

The program featured noted inspirational speaker Dave Runyon, co-author of the book, "The Art of Neighboring," who shared his insights from the book, which draws on the themes of bringing churches, government leaders, civic groups, business owners and community members together to foster a restored sense of neighborhood togetherness.

Runyon, who launched the CityUnite organization in Arvada, Colorado in 2007, has successfully united church, government and civic leaders in tackling community problems head on in the greater Denver metropolitan area. He came away from his first ever trip to Sheboygan impressed with the work of Love INC of Sheboygan County under the leadership of Executive Director Katie Popp.

"It was a great event," Runyon said. "Katie and her team structured it in a way that was engaging and interactive. The stories that were shared were powerful and I'm confident that many in the audience were moved to the point of action."

On Tuesday, October 4th, Runyon met with a group of 40 church and civic leaders during the "Breakfast with Dave" event at First United Lutheran Church in Sheboygan.

"It was great to see the local city mayor [Sheboygan Mayor Mike Vandersteen], state reps [Sen. Devin

LeMahieu and Rep. Terry Katsma], and the mayor of Sheboygan Falls [Mayor Randy Meyer] in attendance," Runyon said. "All of them are passionate about this community and about working with others for the common good. The interaction around each table was robust and was one of the highlights of the event"

Popp was equally satisfied with the inauguration of Love Where You Live.

"We pray that the 'Art of Neighboring' continues after the event and moves into neighborhoods, homes, workplaces and churches throughout Sheboygan County," Popp said.



CLEARINGHOUSE THE HEART OF LOVE INC


The Clearinghouse provides a connection to our Neighbors as we work together to identify the root cause of their circumstances, and help to prayerfully inspire the possibility of a different kind of life – empowering them to take the steps necessary to move toward selfsufficiency. These situations are complex – we understand that identification of the issues, (including resource gaps); communication with a wide range of ministry/service providers to respond to these needs; and, the step-by-step process of building relationship with our Neighbors supports them in breaking the bonds of social isolation and hopelessness as a pathway to a new future. A future in which the Neighbor shifts the trajectory of their life, and becomes a positive force in our communities. Providing a hand-up, rather than a hand-out is our core value, and we believe the answer to ending the generational poverty plaquing so many of our Neighbors.

HOUSING STILL TOPS NEEDS IN COUNTY


The pivotal issue is many Neighbors struggle to maintain safe and stable housing, often relying on short term solutions provided by family and friends who may represent an at-risk situation, as well as limited community emergency housing options. Through our Clearinghouse intake process - we have identified the need for transitional housing for a wide range of circumstances including families evicted from their homes; and, individuals fleeing domestic violence. How can we as a community work to left up those caught in this cycle?
